Eph 4:11-12 NKJV And He Himself gave some to be **apostles**, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, 12 for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry

<u>1 Cor. 12:28</u> NKJV And God has appointed these in the church: **first apostles**, second prophets, third teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, administrations, varieties of tongues.

Apostle: apostello - set apart and sent out

apostolos – an ambassador of the Gospel; messenger

The gift of Apostleship is the divine ability to start and oversee the development of new churches or ministries.

The twelve disciples/Apostles were chosen by Jesus to begin the work of establishing and overseeing the early church. He chose a doctor, fishermen, an accountant, tax collector, doubting Thomas... an assortment of individuals with the gift of Apostle, those who would establish and oversee the new church. The Apostle Paul was also chosen by Jesus, Himself and called on the road to Damascus. Acts 9:1-22

Paul went on to evangelize the Gentiles (non-Jews) and establish churches among them while Peter did the same with the Jews.

<u>Gal 2:7-9</u> NIV they saw that I had been entrusted with the task of preaching the gospel to the Gentiles, just as Peter had been to the Jews. 8 For God, who was at work in the ministry of Peter as an **apostle** to the Jews, was also at work in my ministry as an **apostle** to the Gentiles.

Besides the Apostles eyewitness accounts of Jesus ministry, death and resurrection, the New Testament is mostly a collection of letters written by Paul to the Gentile (non-Jew) churches that he established and oversaw. We draw our structure and order for church planting and oversight from these same words of wisdom given to the early church by Paul.

Rom 1:1 MSG I, Paul, am a devoted slave of Jesus Christ on assignment, authorized as an apostle to proclaim God's words and acts. I write this letter to all the Christians in Rome, God's friends.

1 Cor 1:1; 2 Cor. 1:1; Gal.1:1; Eph 1:1; Col 1:1...etc.

People who have been given the gift of Apostleship love to pioneer new ministries or churches. They adapt to different surroundings by being culturally sensitive and aware. The gift of Apostleship creates a desire to minister to unreached people in other communities and countries and accepts the responsibility to oversee ministries or groups of churches. They demonstrate authority and vision for the mission of the church.
