

Lesson Seven

## "Bereavement Ministry"

Objective: To train and equip students to minister comfort and encouragement to those experiencing the loss of a loved one.

**be-reave-ment**: the state of being sad because a family member or friend has recently died: the death of a family member or friend

Our mission for bereavement ministry is to provide spiritual support, guidance, comfort and love to hurting family members during this difficult time. Through the bereavement ministry we will allow the Holy Spirit to minister the love of Jesus to strengthen them and to bring the knowledge of Christ and eternal life to others.

During bereavement, many questions flood the minds of believers and unbelievers alike. In this lesson we will answer the most commonly asked questions about death. Job lost all of his children in one day and asked the question...

Job 14:14 NKJV If a man dies, shall he live again?

This is a good question. It has been asked throughout generations. Normally no one even likes to think about death. We probably don't even give it a second thought until we are forced to such as when it happens to someone near and dear to us. God included the subject of death in the Bible so that we would have a clear perspective on death.

<u>1 Thess 4:13</u> NKJV But *I do not want you to be ignorant*, brethren, concerning those who have fallen asleep, lest you sorrow as others who have no hope.

### I. What is Death?

<u>1 Thess 5:23</u> NKJV Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Scripture shows us that God has uniquely created humans as tri-part beings.

1. We are	_ who live on the inside of a
physical body and we possess a soul.	

The spirit part of us is the real part that will live and exist eternally. The body serves as the suit that our spirits live and move in. To illustrate this more perfectly, think about

your hand being inside of a glove. If you move your fingers around in the glove, the glove appears to have life. However, when you remove your hand, the glove no longer appears to have life because the part that gave it life has departed from it; so it is with the relationship between the spirit and the body. Physical death occurs when the spirit leaves the body. **Gen 2:7**; **Gen 3:19**; **Ecc 3:2**; **Psalm 31:5**; **Luke 23:46** 

**Eccl 12:7** NKJV Then the dust will return to the earth as it was, and the spirit will return to God who gave it.

**2 Cor 5:8** NKJV We are confident, yes, well pleased rather to be absent from the body and to be present with the Lord.

## II. Why do People Die? Gen 2:17

People of all ages die; infants, adolescents, teens, middle aged and older people. All kinds of people die, Christians and non- Christians and everything in between.

**Heb 9:27** MSG Everyone has to die once, then face the consequences.

Death occurs when the body can no longer sustain life. The body operates according to certain laws and principles. One of the laws is that the organs of the body must function in a certain way in order to keep the body alive. When the organs can no longer sustain the body in the earth, the spirit has to leave. Death can occur because of several reasons.

Infirmity of the flesh is a weakness in the body. It can occur for several reasons. A person can be born with organs malformed or malfunctioning. Please understand that God did not do that. It is a result of sin in the earth.

Another infirmity of the flesh is when something traumatic happens to the body causing injury. Also, because sin and death entered our bodies after Adam and Eve disobeyed

God, our bodies will not last forever as they were created to. The cell regeneration process slows down as we age and the body wears out. <b>Gen 3:22-23</b>

2 Cor. 12:1-4 NLT This boasting will do no good, but I must go on. I will reluctantly tell about visions and revelations from the Lord. 2 la was caught up to the third heaven fourteen years ago. Whether I was in my body or out of my body, I don't know—only God knows. 3 Yes, only God knows whether I was in my body or outside my body. But I do know 4 that I was caught up to paradise and heard things so astounding that they cannot be expressed in words, things no human is allowed to tell.

The walk of life we are in now is only part of what life is all about. Believing in Jesus and trusting Him for forgiveness of our sins and eternal life with God in heaven assures us of an eternity that we will enjoy very much.

1 Cor. 15:50-55 NLT What I am saying, dear brothers and sisters, is that our physical bodies cannot inherit the Kingdom of God. These dying bodies cannot inherit what will last forever. <sup>51</sup> But let me reveal to you a wonderful secret. We will not all die, but we will all be transformed! <sup>52</sup> It will happen in a moment, in the blink of an eye, when the last trumpet is blown. For when the trumpet sounds, those who have died will be raised to live forever. And we who are living will also be transformed. <sup>53</sup> For our dying bodies must be transformed into bodies that will never die; our mortal bodies must be transformed into immortal bodies. <sup>54</sup> Then, when our dying bodies have been transformed into bodies that will never die, <sup>[a]</sup> this Scripture will be fulfilled: "Death is swallowed up in victory. And the dead in Christ will rise first. 17 Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord. 18 Therefore comfort one another with these words.

IV. Comforting Those Who Mourn Through
<u>1.                                    </u>
When someone dies, it can feel overwhelming trying to find the right words to say to comfort the surviving family and friends. The Bible tells us to comfort one another with the words that focus on the promise of eternal life with Jesus. Many times I have found that it's better to <i>be a certain way</i> than it is to <i>say a certain thing</i> . When you don't know what to say just hug! In tragic situations, <b>pointing to our trust in God</b> even when we don't understand brings comfort.
<u>2.</u>
When a family experiences a death, many people find it hard to eat or even think straight. As a church, we bring prepared meals to the bereaved family to try to encourage them to eat and relieve them of that burden.
<u>3.</u>
Prayer makes tremendous power available, dynamic in its working. The prayers we pray for those experiencing the loss of a loved one are the most important thing we can do. Long after the service is over the family is still picking up the pieces and trying to move on with life. We should remember to extend our prayers for the family weeks after the funeral is over.
Pray for peace in the family. Many times that is when the devil starts using the carnality of people to stir up old rifts and power struggles over properties, etc.
<u>4.</u>
Whenever possible, we should be there to support the family during the funeral. It may not seem like much but our presence does make a difference. Just being there expresses the love of the Jesus.
<u>5.</u>
Xceleration Church will send flowers on behalf of the pastors and church as an expression of our care and concern.
<u>6.</u>
Remember that the grief process continues for some time. It can be very meaningful and encouraging to receive a card or a call letting the person know that you are still remembering them in their time of grief for up to a year after their loss.
7. Be ready to
Crisis time is God time. The death of someone we know always causes us to stop and

think and examine our lives and preparedness for our own death. It often becomes an opportunity for others to receive Christ. Be ready to pray the prayer of salvation with

others.

1. Open in prayer –

Father, we honor you in this Holy moment – and this divine appointment – and precious time – for Your word says, precious in your sight is the death of your saints – We are grateful for our Comforter, The Holy Spirit Who is already at work in our hearts and minds.

May the promises of your word steady us and hold us like an anchor.

In Jesus' name - Amen.

## We are here today to do 3 things:

- Glorify God
- Comfort and Encourage one another in the promises of God.
- 2. Scripture Reading: Unison (also play or have music sung at this time of glorifying God)

<u>Psalm 145:3</u> ESV Great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised, and his greatness is unsearchable.

**Zeph 3:17** ESV The LORD your God is in your midst, a mighty one who will save; he will rejoice over you with gladness; he will quiet you by his love...

**Psalm 90:2** NKJV Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever You had formed the earth and the world, Even from everlasting to everlasting, You are God.

<u>1 Chronicles 29:11</u> ESV Yours, O LORD, is the greatness and the power and the glory and the victory and the majesty, for all that is in the heavens and in the earth is yours. Yours is the kingdom, O LORD, and you are exalted as head above all.

3. Remarks: (Celebrating Life) Pre- arrange people to talk about the person in an uplifting way. Let them know they need to keep it to no more than

**3 minutes and usually have no more than two.** (If you do not let people know ahead of time they can go on and on)

The Bible says 'there is a time to mourn.'

This is a time where we really have to trust God's word.

<u>Proverbs 3:3-5</u> Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not to your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge Him and He will direct your path.

Because of the promises of God, we do not mourn as those who have no hope!

<u>1 Thes. 4:13</u> NIV Brothers and sisters, we do not want you to be uninformed about those who sleep in death, so that you do not grieve like the rest of mankind, who have no hope.

\_\_\_\_\_ was a believer – so as a believer listen to the words of Jesus.

**John 11:25-26** NKJV "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live. <sup>26</sup> And whoever lives and believes in Me shall never die."

That's good news but what about this loss – how do we cope with it?

Promise: God will comfort us...

**Psalm 34:18** NIV The LORD is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit.

**Psalm 147:3** NIV He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds.

<u>Joshua 1:9</u> NIV Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for **the LORD your God will be with you wherever you go.**"

You will get through this. With God's help. He promises to help you.

Jesus called it paradise – One thief on the cross – TODAY YOU WILL BE WITH ME IN PARADISE!

**I study near death experiences** – and every one that I've heard of – when Jesus tells them they have to come back – they don't want to! Being at home with God is the greatest thing we can experience.

#### Revelation:

<u>1 Cor 13:12</u> NLT Now we see things imperfectly, like puzzling reflections in a mirror, but then we will see everything with perfect clarity. All that I know now is partial and incomplete, but then I will know everything completely, just as God now knows me completely.

All the mysteries of heaven are being revealed to her. She is seeing the holy angels – the streets of heaven – the **face of Jesus**. The glory of God – the music in heaven - What it feels like **to hug Jesus** – to hold His hand!

<u>1 Cor 13:12</u> MSG We'll see it all then, see it all as clearly as God sees us... knowing him **directly** just as he knows us!

Resurrection:

She has entered the place where she awaits the resurrection:

<u>John 11:25</u> NKJV "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live.

**1 Thes. 4:14-18** NLT For since we believe that Jesus died and was raised to life again, we also believe that when Jesus returns, God will bring back with him the believers who have died. We tell you this directly from the Lord: We who are still living when the Lord returns will not meet him ahead of those who have died. For the Lord himself will come down from heaven with a commanding shout, with the voice of the archangel, and

with the trumpet call of God. First, the believers who have died<sup>[b]</sup> will rise from their graves. <sup>17</sup> Then, together with them, we who are still alive and remain on the earth will be caught up in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. Then we will be with the Lord forever. <sup>18</sup> So encourage each other with these words.

1 Cor. 15:55 NKJV "O Death, where is your sting? O grave, where is your victory?"

MSG Who got the last word, oh, Death? Oh, Death, who's afraid of you now?

Graveside – (you may want to reserve the last point of resurrection for the graveside and then pray -

Lord we commit \_\_\_\_\_\_\_'s body to the ground and to the dust – for out of it we were taken and your word says that our bodies will return to the dust until the resurrection.

# And now into Your Hands Oh Lord we commit his/her spirit to Your love and care until the resurrection that we all eagerly await!

We are trusting you oh lord to comfort and to guide us through this season of grief – Weeping endures for the night but joy comes in the morning!! You will turn for us our mourning into dancing!

## So together we pray like the Lord taught us to pray

Our father who art in heaven hallowed be your name. Your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

For Thine is the kingdom the power and the glory forever amen!

This concludes the graveside service – Remember the family in the coming days and be sure to reach out and text or call – it all means a lot. God bless you.

Be sure to go to each family member and take their hand, look them in the eye and bless them.

The funeral director may take it from there and let the family know what to do next. Sometimes people stay until the body is buried and some leave after the prayer. Be ready to stay and comfort and pray with anyone who needs it. It's a good idea to have some Xceleration Church business cards on hand for anyone who asks.
