"Ministering Healing - Three"

Objective: To train and equip students to minister comfort and healing to those experiencing a hospital stay.

I. The Ministry of Compassion

Hospital stays can be stressful, frustrating and exhausting for the patient and family. We must allow compassion to be the driving force behind our efforts to minister to those experiencing a stay in the hospital. It becomes an opportunity to show the genuine love of God, encouragement, comfort and faith for healing by the church to the patient and the family. Compassion is the driving force that keeps us caring for the hurts of others.

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Col 3:23-24 NKJV And whatever you do, do it heartily, as to the Lord and not to men, 24 knowing that from the Lord you will receive the reward of the inheritance; for you serve the Lord Christ.

<u>AMP</u> Whatever may be your task, work at it heartily (from the soul), **as** [something done] for the Lord and not for men, ²⁴ Knowing [with all certainty] that it is from the Lord [and not from men] that you will receive the inheritance which is your [real] reward. [The One Whom] you are actually serving [is] the Lord Christ (the Messiah).

If we aren't careful, we will lose our desire to care for others. Recognize that not wanting to be bothered is the carnal (flesh) way of thinking. The carnal mind is the enemy of God. That is why it is important that we **set our minds** on the things of the Spirit and offer ourselves to God in serving others.

Rom 8:5-9 NKJV For those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the Spirit, the things of the Spirit. 6 For to be carnally minded is death, but to be spiritually minded is life and peace. 7 Because the carnal mind is enmity against God; for it is not subject to the law of God, nor indeed can be. 8 So then, those who are in the flesh cannot please God. 9 But you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you.

We should have the same mindset that Isaiah had when the Lord asked... 'Whom should I send?'

<u>Isaiah 6:8</u> AMP Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying, Whom shall I send? And who will go for Us? Then said I, **Here am I**; **send me**.

To answer this call to ministry, it's simple. Finish Ministry Development and at graduation you will be commissioned through the laying on of hands and witnessed by the church. Then, be ready for the call to go.
