

**Lesson Three** 

## "Water Baptism Training"

Objective: To provide training for water baptisms.

I. Water Baptism
------------------

1. Water baptism is simply our	with Christ's
death, burial and resurrection when we receive salvation.	-

Rom 6:3-4 NKJV ...as many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? 4 Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

MSG That is what happened in baptism. When we went under the water, we left the old country of sin behind; when we came up out of the water, we entered into the new country of grace — a new life in a new land! That's what baptism into the life of Jesus means. 4 When we are lowered into the water, it is like the burial of Jesus; when we are raised up out of the water, it is like the resurrection of Jesus.

This is why we believe in complete immersion for baptism rather than sprinkling with water. Not that we believe that people who are sprinkled are any less saved because baptism does not save us. Receiving **salvation is by grace** (the free gift of God's unmerited favor) **through faith** (Eph 2:8-9).

The thief on the cross who confessed Jesus never got to be baptized, yet Jesus told him that he would be with him in paradise that same day. However, we seek to follow Jesus' directive for baptism and the scriptures to identify with His death burial and resurrection through total immersion in water.

Matt 28:19-20 NKJV Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen.

Some denominations baptize in Jesus name only. At Xceleration Church, we baptize in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit because we are identifying with the power of all three Persons of the Godhead in our new life. The **Father** is the One Who loved me enough to send His **Son** to die for me. **The Holy Spirit** drew me to Jesus and He begins His work of transforming me into the image of Christ.

Acts 8:36-38 NKJV Now as they went down the road, they came to some water. And the eunuch said, "See, here is water. What hinders me from being baptized?" 37 Then Philip said, "If you believe with all your heart, you may."And he answered and said, "I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God." 38 So he commanded the chariot to stand still. And both Philip and the eunuch went down into the water, and he baptized him.

<u>John 4:1-2</u> MSG Jesus realized that the Pharisees were keeping count of the baptisms that he and John performed 2 (although his disciples, not Jesus, did the actual baptizing).

We encourage you, because you have proven yourself to be a true disciple of Jesus to join us in performing baptisms of new believers at Xceleration Church. Acts 2:41 NIV ...those who accepted his message were baptized, and about three thousand were added to their number that day.

It took every disciple available to baptize 3,000 in one day!

Acts 8:12 NIV But when they believed Philip as he preached the good news of the kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ, they were baptized, both men and women.

Acts 18:8 NIV Crispus, the synagogue ruler, and his entire household believed in the Lord; and many of the Corinthians who heard him believed and were baptized.

<u>Acts 16:30-33</u> NKJV "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?" So they said, "Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved, you and your household." 32 Then they spoke the word of the Lord to him and to all who were in his house. 33 And he took them the same hour of the night and washed their stripes. And immediately he and all his family were baptized.

<u>Acts 16:14-15</u> MSG One woman, Lydia, was from Thyatira and a dealer in expensive textiles, known to be a God-fearing woman. As she listened with intensity to what was being said, the Master gave her a trusting heart — and she believed! 15 **After she was baptized**, along with everyone in her household, she said in a surge of hospitality, "If you're confident that I'm in this with you and believe in the Master truly, come home with me and be my guests."

Children can be baptized when they are old enough to understand and make the decision to accept Jesus.
